To foreign nationals who were affected by earthquakes in Kumamoto

Fukuoka Regional Immigration Bureau (including branch offices under its jurisdiction) provides consultation on procedures at the immigration bureau for victims of the Kumamoto earthquake.

If you have problems such as you cannot obtain documents necessary to application procedures, you can feel free to consult at your nearest immigration bureau or immigration information center.

If you are a victim of the Kumamoto earthquake and evacuated temporarily your place of residence, and when you need to go through various procedures at the immigration bureau, please inform of it at the inspection counter of the immigration bureau.

At that time, you do not need to change your address to an evacuation shelter nor bring a Disaster Victim Certificate.
